## Moving into this Next Chapter

This March, after over a year of talking, planning and re-scheduling, we were able to have our congregational ministry review visit from the synod at United.

This May, we received the synod's written ministry review from their visit. Their report was well-written and included affirmations and challenges for our congregation based on their observations.

The synod's affirmations of our strengths:

- a variety of worship formats and strong musical talent;
- Sunday school and participation of young people in worship;
- mission-mindedness in Haiti and our community, beyond our congregation;
- mission statement;
- hospitality;
- openness to new ideas;
- pastors well-liked, respected and engaged in community;
- building is accessible and used by the community.

Challenges and opportunities for ULC:

- secularization in society;
- perceived stigma in our community related to those with chemical dependency, mental health issues or in need of financial assistance;
- engaging more members in the various ministries of our congregation;
- continued engagement of youth after confirmation and through high school;
- the number of households with little recorded financial contribution;
- reliance upon pastoral staff.

There is much to be thankful for at United and there continues to be much we can do as Jesus' disciples!

As a congregation, we have been blessed to have two (officially one-and-a-half) pastors for almost five years. I know many of you are wondering what is next for United, with Pastor Rebecca's call to Walhalla-Big Pembina. You may be mourning or sad or even upset about her announcement. Our congregation has been incredibly blessed by Pastor Rebecca's ministry. I have certainly been blessed to work with her, not only as a spouse, but as a co-pastor in ministry.

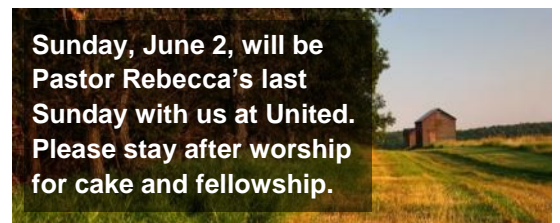

## Council Notes 05-20-19 Mtg

The synod's congregational ministry review has been received and distributed to our ministry review task force to make recommendations for next steps. Pastor Karl referred to the synod's strength's and challenges identified at United for our opening devotional.

There has not yet been a volunteer(s) to fill the Sunday School Coordinator position so the Education Committee is planning to assume those responsibilities for the fall.

The Property committee is looking at options for repairing downspouts damaged this winter. Mikkelsen Brothers Construction will check the problematic sewage pipe in the parking lot this summer and bring in more gravel for the parking lot.

The Stewardship Committee has been counting and depositing Sunday cash offerings.

One of the pews in the sanctuary has been shortened to make wheelchair accessibility.

July 28 will be the annual outdoor worship and church picnic. Council and committee responsibilities were distributed.

Sunday, June 16, we will drive to Rapid City and will be staying with other church youth groups at Trinity Lutheran Church.



During our week, we will have a variety of service and learning opportunities. These include staffing VBS for area children, visiting Crazy Horse Monument and other cultural sites. Also, volunteering at the Hope Center ([www.hopecenterrapidcity.org](http://www.hopecenterrapidcity.org)) which ministers to those living in poverty without homes and other area non-profit organizations. We are accepting in-kind donations to bring with us to the Hope Center which may be placed in a tote in the church near the coat racks. A list of their current needs can be found on their website.
